As a rule one tablet should be taken per day. The drug should never be taken in a dosage exceeding the recommended because of the high probability of side effects and overdose symptoms development. The attending physician can reduce the dosage for those patients who are over 65 years old or have a history of serious liver or kidney disease. How to take? The tablet should be washed down with plenty amount of water. In addition, you can't combine Sildenafil-containing drugs with such antifungal drugs as Itraconazole, Ketoconazole. Among the drugs that exclude joint use include anticoagulants, some barbiturates, beta-blockers, HIV inhibitors, other drugs for the treatment of erectile disorders, drugs for high blood pressure treatment, as well as some drugs against epilepsy. In the case of treatment with the above list of the preparations, it may be necessary to change the dose of their administration or to closely monitor the manifestation of side effects.
